



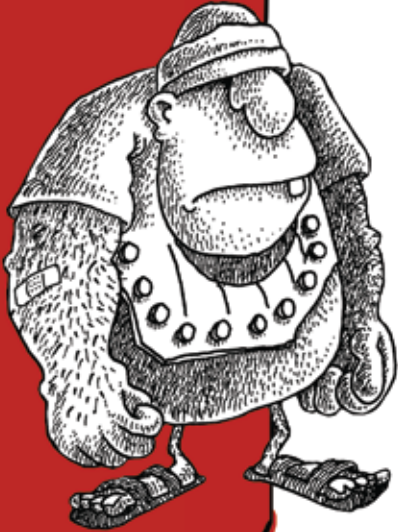

**Outnumbered?**

*Here's a small sample of the plaintiffs' cases we've won:*

### **Wrongful Death**

#### *Coggins, et al. v. KLLM, Inc., et al.*

Tennessee case involving the death of a teenager in a truck crash. \$6.9 million verdict, upheld on appeal.

#### *Daniel v. Dirob Corp.*

\$825,000 paid on behalf of 91-year-old woman killed in truck crash.

#### *Alexander, et al. v. Jet Fleet, et al.*

\$3.8 million verdict (affirmed on appeal) in wrongful death aviation case. This was the largest verdict in Hunt County, Texas, until we won the Raytheon case below.

### **Personal Injury**

#### *Holmes v. Sprint*

Multimillion-dollar settlement in Tarrant County electrocution/electrical burn case.

### **Commercial / Fraud**

#### *Raytheon v. Learjet*

\$27 million verdict, largest in Hunt County history, including \$11 million in punitive damages. Case settled near full value.

#### *Adams, Cardwell & Russell v. Lloyds of London, et al.*

\$3.9 million jury verdict – paid – in case involving the death of a race horse.

#### *Interstate Southwest Ltd. v. Lycoming*

\$96 million verdict and judgment in case involving worldwide recall of general aviation aircraft engines. To prove our clients' point, we bought some of the engines and tested them on our own. Damage award set aside, but key verdict components upheld, negating opponents' \$173 million counterclaim.

### **Intellectual Property**

#### *Maxma v. ConocoPhillips*

Confidential settlement (so good, we can't talk about it).

### **Wrongful termination / slander / defamation**

#### *Fisher v. Pinnacle*

\$9.8 million award in the case of a doctor who blew the whistle on a billing scheme designed to bill patients at higher rates by intentionally sending them to out-of-network doctors.
